## 1. Duty & grade

- Environment: media, temperature, stress
- Grade if specified — or duty so we can propose
- Honest question: would 316L survive? (We will ask)

## 2. Definition

- Drawing/model with tolerances
- Weld joints and acceptance (colour class)
- Surface finish and cleaning spec

## 3. Evidence

- Mill certs (standard, always)
- Dye-pen / hydro test requirements
- Heat-lot traceability needs

## 4. Commercial

- Quantities and dates
- Delivery terms
